Regular APEC energy data collection

- Annual energy supply and demand data for 2016 have been collected.
- Publication of APEC Energy Statistics and Handbook 2016 will be in mid-November 2018.
- Regular monthly and quarterly data collection continues.
- Low response rate on the energy efficiency indicators template
 - No available end-use energy consumption (heating, cooling, lighting, etc.) data in many economies
 - Need for training on how to estimate these data

16th APEC workshop on energy statistics

- Held in Tokyo on 10-12 July 2018
 - 28 participants from 16 economies, 4 experts from 4 international organisations and APERC staff
- Key Topics
 - Shared experiences and challenges faced by the APEC member economies in:
 - Collection of end-use energy consumption and
 - New and renewable energy data
 - Sharing of information on district cooling and discussion on secretariat's proposal to include it in the energy balance table
 - Clarification of missing data points in the JODI Oil and JODI Gas data submissions

EGEDA's short- and middle-term training (2018)

- Short-Term: 20-31 August 2018 (2 weeks)
 - 12 trainees from 7 economies (Brunei Darussalam; Indonesia; Malaysia; Papua New Guinea; the Philippines; Singapore; and Viet Nam) and 1 international organization (ASEAN Center for Energy)
- Middle-Term: 20 August to 12 October 2018 (8 weeks)
 - 2 trainees from 2 economies (China and Thailand)
- Merged the courses for the first two weeks to optimize APERC's staff resources
