- Annual Energy Demand-Supply Data in 2013
- Quarterly Energy Supply Data in 2014 to 2015
- CO<sub>2</sub> Emission Data in 2013
- Energy Price Data in 2013
- Release of Energy Statistics and Handbook publications for 2013 will be around September to October 2015 just before next EWG

### Coming soon

- Regular collection of end-use energy consumption data in residential and commercial sectors
- Regular collection of detailed renewable energy demand-supply data in harmonization with IRENA data collection

- Major discussion points
  - EGEDA reported on current data collection of renewable energy data and the revised NRE questionnaire to be used for its future collection
  - EGEDA pointed out NRE data issues on thermal efficiency of primary electricity;
    - Hydro, solar, wind, tide: 100%
    - Nuclear: 33%
    - Geothermal: 10% or actual efficiency
    - Biomass: actual efficiency

# **JODI Activity (3)**

#### • JODI Conference

- Date: 8-10 May 2015
- Venue: New Delhi, India
- Theme: "10 Year of the JODI-Oil Database, 1 Year of the JODI-Gas Database"
- Participants
  - A total 90 delegates representing 25 countries/economies, as well as energy data experts, market analysts, financial sector, media and oil & gas industry
  - From APEC region: Pertamina commissioner, energy data experts from Canada, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and USA. Philipps66 (Singapore trading company)
- Further actions identified in the Conference;
  - Enhancement of the quality of JODI data
  - Review of data reporting mechanisms (M-1)
  - Strengthening of capacity building efforts
  - Engagement with the JODI user/energy data analytics community
  - Raising JODI brand-awareness (media)
  - Extension of JODI (ex. coal)
  - JODI Champions (G20)
  - 5-Year Plan

## **JODI Activity (4)**

### JODI ISWG Meeting

- Date: 10-11 June 2015
- Venue: University of Geneva, Geneva, Switzerland
- Purpose: Review of the New Delhi Conference
- Participants
  - APEC, EUROSTAT, GECF, IEA, IEF, UNSD
  - OPEC joined through conference call
  - OLADE was absent
- Technical meeting
  - Web-based JODI data uploading system (harmonization of source file format)
  - Confirm standard quality assessment methodology to JODI gas data
  - Use of standardized JODI training materials
- ISWG meeting
  - IEA/OPEC presented JODI activities at IEF GB meeting on June 8 at OPEC secretariat
  - Review of the JODI conference in New Delhi
  - Strict assessment on timeliness (worsen smiley faces)
- JODI User Seminar
  - Oil and gas trading companies in Geneva such as TOTAL and LUKOIL
    - JODI data should downloadable in be a variety of formats
    - Additional tables to process JODI data
    - Quick response to questions related to JODI data, etc

### **Other Issues**

- The coordinating agency of EGEDA has changed from EDMC/IEEJ to ESTO/APERC/IEEJ from April 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, but this is just an internal change under IEEJ's umbrella;
  - ESTO: Energy Statistics Training Office
  - Three persons in charge of APEC energy statistics has moved from EDMC to ESTO
  - Head of ESTO is Mr. Masazumi Hirono
  - In this regard, TOR of EGEDA has been revised out of session in March 2015

- Regular Data Collection will start from November 2015
  - Annual Data in 2014
  - Quarterly Data in 2015 to 2016
  - CO<sub>2</sub> Emission Data in 2014
  - Energy Price Data in 2014
