- **promote low-emission power sources such as renewable energy, nuclear and fossil fuel with CCS; and**
- **provide recommendations for the host economy.**

- **Phase 1 (2012-2013): Thailand, the Philippines**
- **Phase 2 (2013-2014): Indonesia, Malaysia**
- **Phase 3 (2014-2016): Viet Nam**
- **Phase 4 (2017): Papua New Guinea**
