Regular APEC energy data collection

- Annual energy supply and demand data for 2016 are now being collected.
- Ten member economies have submitted data.
- Processing will start as soon as data are received.
- Publication of APEC Energy Statistics and Handbook 2016 will be in October 2018.
- Regular monthly and quarterly data collection continues.

16th APEC workshop on energy statistics

- Will be held in Tokyo on 10-12 July 2018
- Information Exchange:
 - Information sharing on district heating/cooling systems and related energy data
 - Sharing of experiences in the collection of end-use energy efficiency indicators and new and renewable energy data
 - Filling-in the JODI Oil and JODI Gas data gaps
 - Next steps for further exchanges

EGEDA's short- and middle-term training (2018)

- Short-Term: 20-31 August 2018 (2 weeks)
 - 8-9 trainees from travel-eligible economies
- Middle-Term: 20 August to 12 October 2018 (8 weeks)
 - One trainee each from two economies
- Invitation sent to member economies in the last week of April
- Merged the courses for the first two weeks to optimize APERC's staff resources

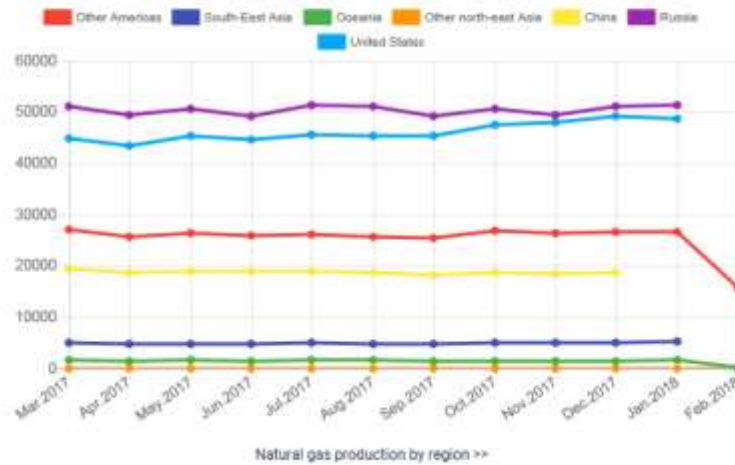

30th EGEDA meeting

- Indonesia offered to host the 30th meeting in the first quarter of 2019
- Announcement of the meeting will be circulated as soon as complete information on schedule and venue are available

EGEDA/ESTO participation in JODI events

- EGEDA and its secretariat have been participating in JODI activities since 2001 as a “joint activity” with EUROSTAT, IEA, IEF, GECF, OLADE, OPEC and UNSD.
- Monthly oil and gas data collection became a regular activity in APEC because of JODI.
- JODI is continuously evolving following requests of IEF members’ energy ministers and data users.
- ESTO will continue to be participating in JODI events.
- There are as many as eight JODI events per year (at the maximum).
- APEC secretariat reminder that participation in non-member events should be approved by SOM.
- It is therefore requested that EWG gives a batch approval for three years to EGEDA/ESTO’s participation in JODI events.

Revision of EGEDA ToR

- As directed by APEC Fora Governance, all APEC fora including EWG and its sub-fora needed to revise their ToRs to cover two main issues:
 - Quorum
 - Sunset clause
- EGEDA revised its ToR to include a sunset clause as follows:
 - “EGEDA has a term of four years starting from 2018. At the expiration of this and any subsequent term, EGEDA and its ToR shall be reviewed (by EGEDA and EWG) and a recommendation on renewal put to EWG for approval.”
- A specific objective was also added as follows:
 - To track the APEC aspirational goals on reducing energy intensity by 45% by 2035 from 2005 levels and doubling the 2010 share of renewable energy in APEC energy mix by 2030.
